The annual grade point average (GPA) of students determines their academic standing. The average of academic standing: good standing, academic probation, deferred dismissal and academic dismissal.

1. Good Academic Standing

In order to maintain good academic standing full-time students must earn a minimum annual GPA of 2.0 in each year of their program. Part-time students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 on each block of 30 credit hours earned.

2. Academic Probation

Academic probation follows on notice of insufficient academic performance and is a warning to the student to improve immediately in order to avoid academic dismissal. Students placed on academic probation shall have their academic record reviewed each semester by the Registrar to determine if they are making progress. A student whose annual GPA falls below 2.0 but above 1.5 is placed on academic probation. A student who has been placed on academic probation and whose annual GPA in any subsequent year falls below 2.0 will be dismissed from the University.

3. Deferred Dismissal Policy
