

D. Codes of Student Conduct (Academic Misconduct - Excerpt)

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SECTION I - ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT

1. Plagiarism

Plagiarism is the use of another person's work without proper citation. [a citation is a reference to the source of information.] (The Modern Language Association Handbook for Writers of Research Papers, J. G. A. S., 1999, p. 30).

Appeal to be Re-admitted to the University after Academic Dismissal
